**SUBJECT: WAYFINDING SIGNAGE - UPDATE**

---

The Advisory Committee has identified the Wayfinding Signage Project as the next highest priority for use of the Fairplex Mitigation Fund. City staff will be developing a scope of work for a consultant to map and inventory, conduct outreach, review traffic patterns/uses, develop wayfinding design/branding, and ultimately a project implementation plan. The consultant will be tasked with determining estimated costs for the project. The current City priority is completion of the Citywide Pomona Safety Action Plan anticipated to be adopted in late Spring.

Staff has been involved in 2028 Olympics planning discussions due to the Fairgrounds being identified as Cricket Stadium Venue which may impact the Wayfinding signage recommendations. Additionally, an Active Transportation Plan project is in planning phase for a Class IV Bike Lane (separated) along the south side of Arrow – helping to connect the Pomona North Train Station to the Fairplex and other Pomona destinations – also potentially impacting signage recommendations.
