SECTION 1: ETHICS COMMISSION DEFINITION

The Ethics commission was created by charter amendment, voted on by the electorate in 2022. The Ethics Commission is the main point for advice, education, policy review, campaign matters (including proactive audits on select campaign contributions and expenditures) and general information for Ethics related matters for Elected Officials, Commissioners and the general public in Pomona. The Ethics Commission is responsible for developing and implementing an Ethics enforcement policy that applies to Elected Officials and Commissioners and begins after City staff conduct an investigation and intake process and provide the findings to the Ethics Commission for review and enforcement action (including required penalties and disciplinary actions to be imposed per law or necessary referrals to other agencies). The Commission is not an independent investigative or enforcement body and can only provide recommendations to the City Council.
