## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-121**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCREASE REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$440,000

**WHEREAS**, the State of California's Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) has awarded a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant to the City of Pomona to reduce the number of persons killed and/or injured in vehicle collisions involving alcohol, speed, red light violations and other driver behaviors. The grant period begins October 1, 2025, and continues through September 30, 2026; and,

**WHEREAS,** the total amount of \$440,000 will be used to achieve the goals of the grant through education, field operations and acquiring equipment;

**WHEREAS**, the authority to accept the STEP Grant and amend the current revenue and operating budgets to appropriate the OTS grant funds to be received is vested with City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-26 Special Operational budget by increasing revenue estimates (215-2014-40875-58825) and appropriations (215-2014-5XXXX-58825) in the amount of \$440,000.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into the grant agreement on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 3.** The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
