

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCREASE REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$440,000

WHEREAS, the State of California's Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) has awarded a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant to the City of Pomona to reduce the number of persons killed and/or injured in vehicle collisions involving alcohol, speed, red light violations and other driver behaviors. The grant period begins October 1, 2025, and continues through September 30, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, the total amount of \$440,000 will be used to achieve the goals of the grant through education, field operations and acquiring equipment;

WHEREAS, the authority to accept the STEP Grant and amend the current revenue and operating budgets to appropriate the OTS grant funds to be received is vested with City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-26 Special Operational budget by increasing revenue estimates (215-2014-40875-58825) and appropriations (215-2014-5XXXX-58825) in the amount of \$440,000.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into the grant agreement on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
