RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Parking Place Commissioners approve the above subject action.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

To ensure timely processing of VPD parking permit sales, the VPD Commission has authorized staff to issue permits to qualified applicants immediately upon receipt of their application and payment. The Commission's action formalizes and ratifies the issuance of these permits.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The VPD received a total of \$115 for the sale of two (2) new parking permits.

DISCUSSION:

As the sale of parking permits involves public funds, the VPD Commission must ratify the issuance of each new permit. This ensures transparency, impartiality, and provides a documented record of active VPD parking permits. During this reporting period, two (2) new parking permits were sold. *Residential Parking Permits*

1. Richard Leal – Issued 1/21/2025

Lot Specific Parking Permits

2. Zacharias Casady – Issued 1/28/2025

Renewals of existing parking permits do not require additional ratification beyond the approval of the initial issuance and ratification by the Commission. These purchases are documented in the parking inventory summary sheet (Attachment No. 1), which details the available spaces in each VPD parking lot, the number of permits issued, and the number of permit holders who did not renew for information only.

If new permits have been issued, corresponding applications are included as Attachment No. 2. At present, there is sufficient parking to accommodate the additional permit holders.
