**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF THE STANDARDS AND TRAINING FOR
CORRECTIONS (STC) GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,383**

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-201 – A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA ACCEPTING THE
STANDARDS AND TRAINING FOR CORRECTIONS (STC) GRANT IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$25,383 AND AMENDING THE FY 2022-23
OPERATING BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES AND
APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SAME AMOUNT**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Action on this item will accept the STC grant in the amount of \$25,383 from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC). These funds will be used to meet required training and certification for Police Department Jail staff.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impact is neutral due to an increase increased revenue estimates of \$25,383 (215-2090-40873-58768) and corresponding appropriation in the same amount (215-2090-5XXXX-58768).

PREVIOUS RELATED ACTION:

On August 2, 2021, City Council accepted the STC Grant for FY 2021-22 in the amount of \$13,500.

DISCUSSION:

The Police Department has been awarded a one-year STC grant in the amount of \$25,383 to meet State of California required training for Jail staff. The grant period covers July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 and funds will be disbursed on a quarterly basis. The acceptance of the award is being brought retroactively due to notification of the award not being received to allow the Department to prepare the resolution and staff report prior to the grant performance period beginning.

The STC program is a division of the BSCC. The purpose of the STC program is to provide funding for ongoing training and professional development for police jail staff. This program develops standards for selection & training, course certification and training support.

COUNCIL PRIORITIES & GOALS: This item supports the 2021-2022 City Council Priority 1: Fiscal and Operational Responsibility – Goal C: Obtain additional grant funding and other revenues to help achieve City goals.
