CRAFTSMAN 1911



Clad in wood shingles, this two-story Craftsman was built in 1911. A projecting gabled roof caps the front porch and entryway. Brick piers support the four-post columns. The wide wood front door is flanked by sidelights. One triple-set transom window and a plate glass window face the front. The second floor features a balcony which has now been enclosed with a screen. The windows are double-hung with muntin work outlining the frame.
