

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, TO ADOPT A TECHNOLOGY DISRUPTION POLICY FOR REMOTE MEETING PARTICIPATION AS REQUIRED BY SENATE BILL 707

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 707 (SB 707) was signed into law on October 3, 2025 by Governor Newsom; and

WHEREAS, SB 707 updates key Brown Act Provisions with the intent to increase public engagement in meetings of local legislative bodies; and

WHEREAS, SB 707 requires the City to formally adopt a policy, on or before July 1, 2026, that establishes a procedure for responding to a disruption in service that affects remote participation and the efforts that the staff and City Council shall make in attempt to restore the service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The policy “Disruption of Internet Service or Two-Way Remote Access Technology During Public Meetings”, is hereby adopted. (Exhibit A)

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
