703	TJPA	Salesforce Transit Center Wayfinding Phase 1B	\$	\$ 300,000	Requested funds will improve the Salesforce Transit Center's wayfinding system by replacing 100 of the 318 media players at interactive and non-interactive kiosks throughout the Center that have reached the end of their useful life. This project was recommended by TJPA's Wayfinding Gap Analysis (2020) to improve the reliability and fun wayfinding system. It would improve the commuter and visitor experience by providing them quickly and more efficiently to transit connections and to the public activities provided at the Center's rooftop park. This project is consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's (MTC) current standards for wayfinding and supports a smoother rollout of MTC's new regional standards (when completed) for seamless transit connections across the region. TJPA expects to complete this request by December 2023.
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
