

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-128

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 WATER FUND BUDGET, RECEIVING AND INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES BY \$120,000 OF METROPOLITAN WATER DISTRICT FROM THE MEMBER AGENCY ADMINISTERED-INCENTIVE PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE RESIDENTIAL LANDSCAPE EVALUATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Pomona City Charter requires that amendments to the Adopted Budget be approved by resolution, with approval of the Pomona City Council;

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) is offering grant funds for the Member Agency Administered-incentive Programs (MAAP) for the Residential Landscape Evaluation Program in the amount of \$120,000;

WHEREAS, said grant funds will foster water conservation awareness in the context of our residents' yards and homes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-2026 Water Fund Revenue budget, by increasing revenue estimates by receiving and allocating \$120,000 (571-8127-40380-51356) from the MWD MAAP reimbursable grant for the Residential Landscape Evaluation Program.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
