

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-157

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROPRIATING FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2022 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY DE-ESCALATION GRANT AND AMENDING FY 2023-24 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCREASE REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS BY \$181,260

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded a Law Enforcement De-Escalation Grant from the Office of Community Oriented Policing (COPS) for a total award of \$181,260;

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement De-Escalation Grant has been awarded to fund the Pomona Police Department's efforts to train and equip its officers to utilize de-escalations techniques as an alternative to using force when appropriate.

WHEREAS, the authority to amend the current revenue and operating budgets to appropriate the COPS grant funds to be received is vested with City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby amends the FY 2023-24 Police Department Grants Fund budget revenue estimate by \$181,260 (215-2090-40875-58753), with a corresponding \$181,260 appropriation (215-2090-5XXXX-58753).

SECTION 2. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all agreements on behalf of the City, in substantially the form submitted, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That City Clerk shall attest to and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
