SUBJECT: INFORMATION ON THE REQUEST TO INSTALL A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT WHITE AVENUE AT BURDICK DRIVE

At the Fairplex Mitigation Fund Advisory Committee meeting on May 20, 2025, the committee asked staff to see if a traffic signal could be installed at White Avenue at Burdick Drive. This location is beyond the committee's purview and would not be able to make recommendations to have a traffic signal installed. This report is for informational purposes only.

To install a traffic signal a Traffic Signal (TS) warrant analysis would need to be conducted to determine if a traffic signal is justifiable. Around 2022, the City was working with Caltrans on a new HOV lane for Rapid transit along the 10 freeway. Part of that project was to upgrade the EB off-ramp alignment to continue straight into White Ave with a proposed signal or roundabout (Attachment No. 1). Burdick at White would be turned into a cul-de-sac. However, this project has been placed on-hold by Caltrans.
