

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-118

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING FY 2025-26 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCREASE REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS BY \$45,645

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded a Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program Grant from the Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) in the amount of \$45,645;

WHEREAS, the Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Grant has been awarded to fund the Pomona Police Department's efforts to reduce the number of pedestrian and bicycle incidents that cause injury or death. These efforts are set to commence October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026;

WHEREAS, the authority to accept the Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program Grant and amend FY 2025-26 Special Operating budget by increasing revenue estimates and appropriations is vested with City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-26 Special Operating Budget by increasing revenue estimate (215-2014-40873-58823) appropriations (215-2014-51039-58823) in the amount of \$39,819 and (215-2014-52430-58823) in the amount of \$5,826.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all agreements on behalf of the City, in substantially the form submitted, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That City Clerk shall attest to and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
