

# Parks Needs & Prioritization

Parks & Recreation Commission  
April 16, 2026

The City is conducting a comprehensive Park Needs Assessment to identify deficiencies and establish a prioritized list of recommended park improvements.

To ensure a fair, organized, and transparent review sequence, the Parks and Recreation Commission listed park needs for the first 15 of 34 parks (listed by alphabetical order). These priorities were discussed at the March 19, 2026 Parks and Recreation Commission meeting.

The remaining parks will be discussed at the April 16, 2026 Parks and Recreation Commission meeting.

At this time, Measure A funds are the only ongoing planned park investment funding source. Measure A is intended to support improvements to the City's park and open space system.

Findings from these evaluations will assist in the development of a prioritized improvement list and help guide future planning, budgeting, grant proposals, and capital investment decisions.

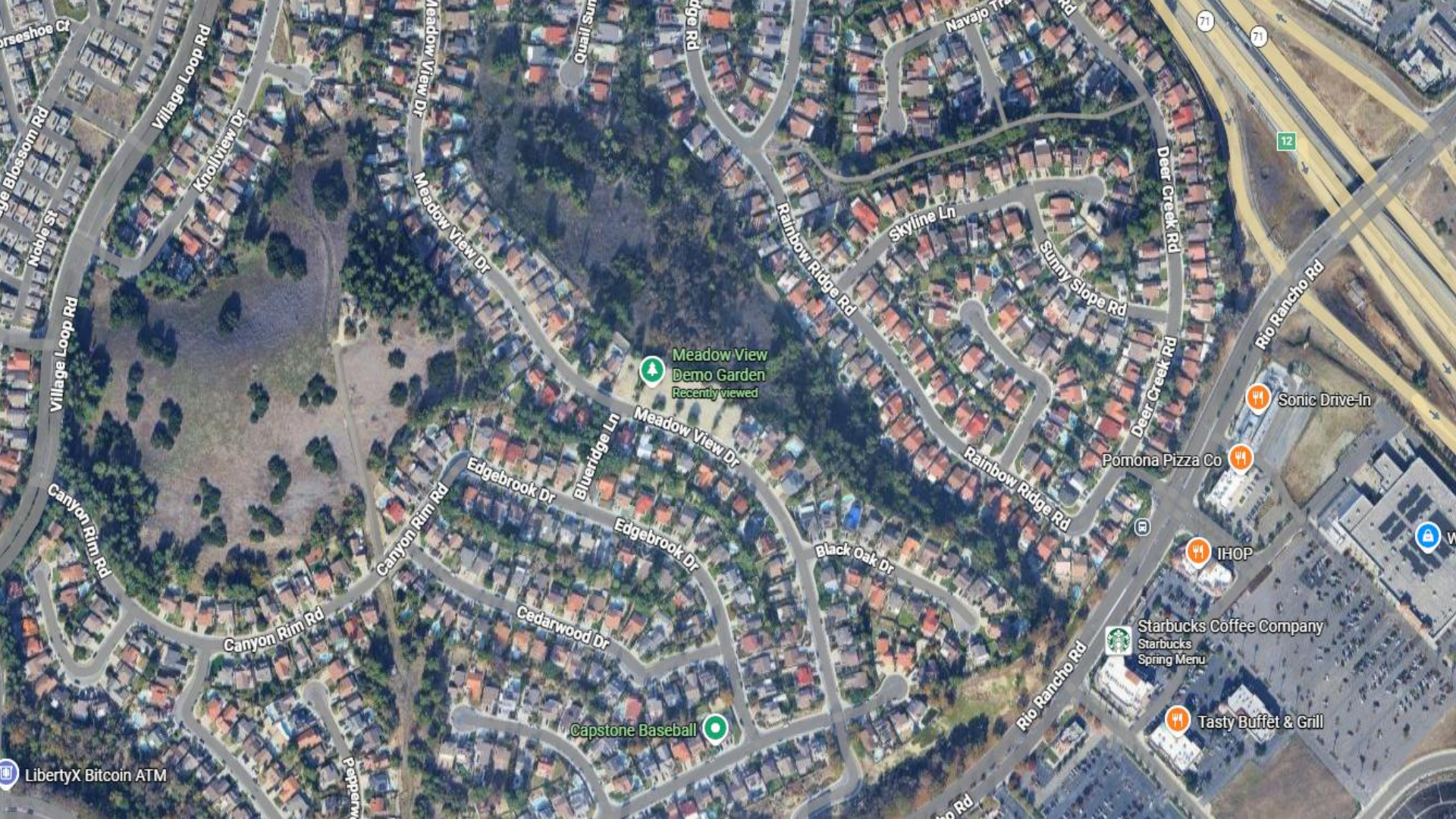
This structured process is intended to balance staff's responsibility to address safety and risk management needs with the Commission's advisory role in representing community use, priorities, and values.

This is not a comprehensive list and excludes minor maintenance e.g. sprinkler repair, graffiti removal, etc.

The list is intended to serve as a guide for projects of the highest priority and to guide the expenditure of limited park improvement funding, including Measure A funds.

## Staff Recommendations:

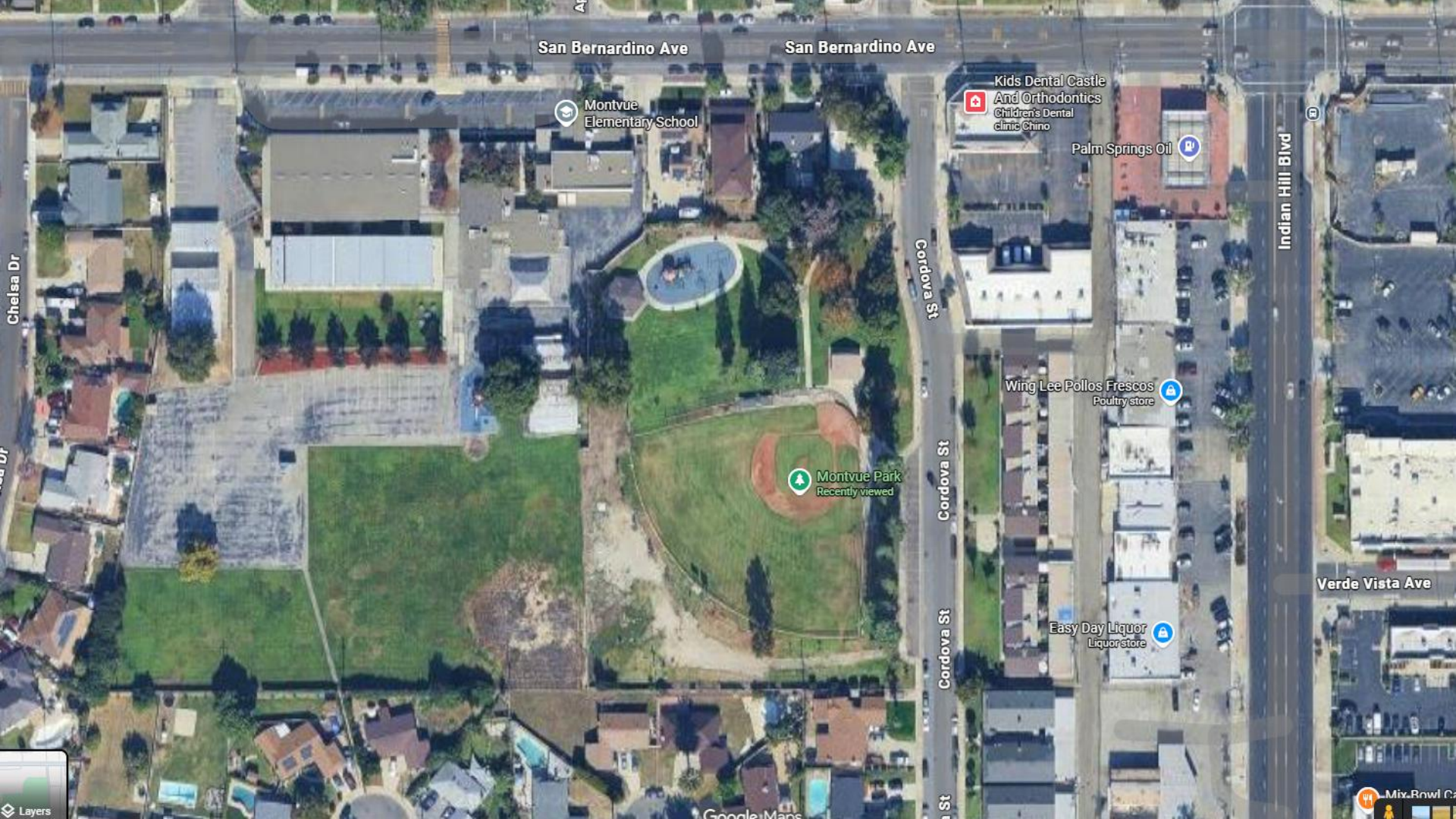
- Subject to P&R Ad Hoc Committee and master plan process

# 17. Memorial Park, 655 W. Third Ave.

## P&R Commission Recommendations:

- One of the few parks without an updated play set. Families use this park often. If we decide to keep the structure, it would be nice to add a mural to it. Maybe some painted mile/distance markers surrounding the park, because people often walk the perimeter. An additional dog waste receptacle on the west side of the park would also be great! Art walk is usually the only day that the entire parking lot fills up. Could there be an alternate use for the west side of the lot?
- Updated playground. Concrete picnic tables.
- Needs more flowers around memorial and play equipment needs a good cleaning.
- Building needs to be repainted, but overall needs structural upgrades, new trash bins, playground is outdated and needs to be updated, signs around the park need to be updated they are old or painted over, new paint lines on parking spots, need new basketball nets, parking lot needs repaving in certain areas as it is a trip hazard, it would be nice to have plants around the park i.e. flowers, drought tolerant plants.

- Add bleachers
- Add playground
- Complete Water Dept. project enhancements (walking paths and lighting)
- Redo dugouts (1 roof) and other needs
- Hard surface futsal courts
- Pickleball
- Replace fencing if it stays a baseball park
- Parking lot
- CPTED under oak tree shade, tree removal
- PUSD discussions for field, parking lot, entrance

## P&R Commission Recommendations:

- Highly problematic - a lot of transient and unhoused folks. The play structure is not even visible from the nearest street. Felt unsafe; I didn't get out of my car.
- Upgraded restrooms. Additional lighting throughout the park. Walking path around the perimeter of park.
- Needs flowers.
- Playground swings need to be sanded and painted over or replace it with a new set. Next to the scoreboard, there's a "billboard" there consider removing it or repurposing it, new scoreboard, shade sails/structures to be added where benches are at, dug out "roof" needs to be replaced as it is worn down. The old playground has been torn down. What is the city considering building there? another playground? I also noticed a lot of homeless in that park hanging out.

## **Community Center/Senior Area:**

- Consolidate community center entrance with rental office
- Working restrooms for stage
- Create Tai-chi area /Zen/Meditation area
- New concrete for uneven patio area
- Redo the exit coming down the stairs, with panic bar instead of sliding gate

## **La Casita Area:**

- Add fitness area (north of the teen center) underneath trees
- Increase lighting on northside

## **Skate Area:**

- Add lighting for skatepark
- Add shade for skatepark
- Add drinking fountain by skate park
- Fix walkway by skatepark

## **Sports Court / Playground Area:**

- Add security lighting for playground
- Add shade for basketball court / solar
- Redo playgrounds or combine playground areas

## **Tennis/Pickleball Area:**

- Add gate swing arm / security gate for loading dock area
- Put gate for the exit on the northside by lobby.
- Security (lighting and cameras) and wrought iron fencing for storage containers
- Complete the walkway for park perimeter
- License plate reader at entrance.
- Review agreement/use including ADA upgrades for lawn bowling
- The curb near lawn bowling needs to be painted
- Enclose south dock area and connect area for storage with motion detectors

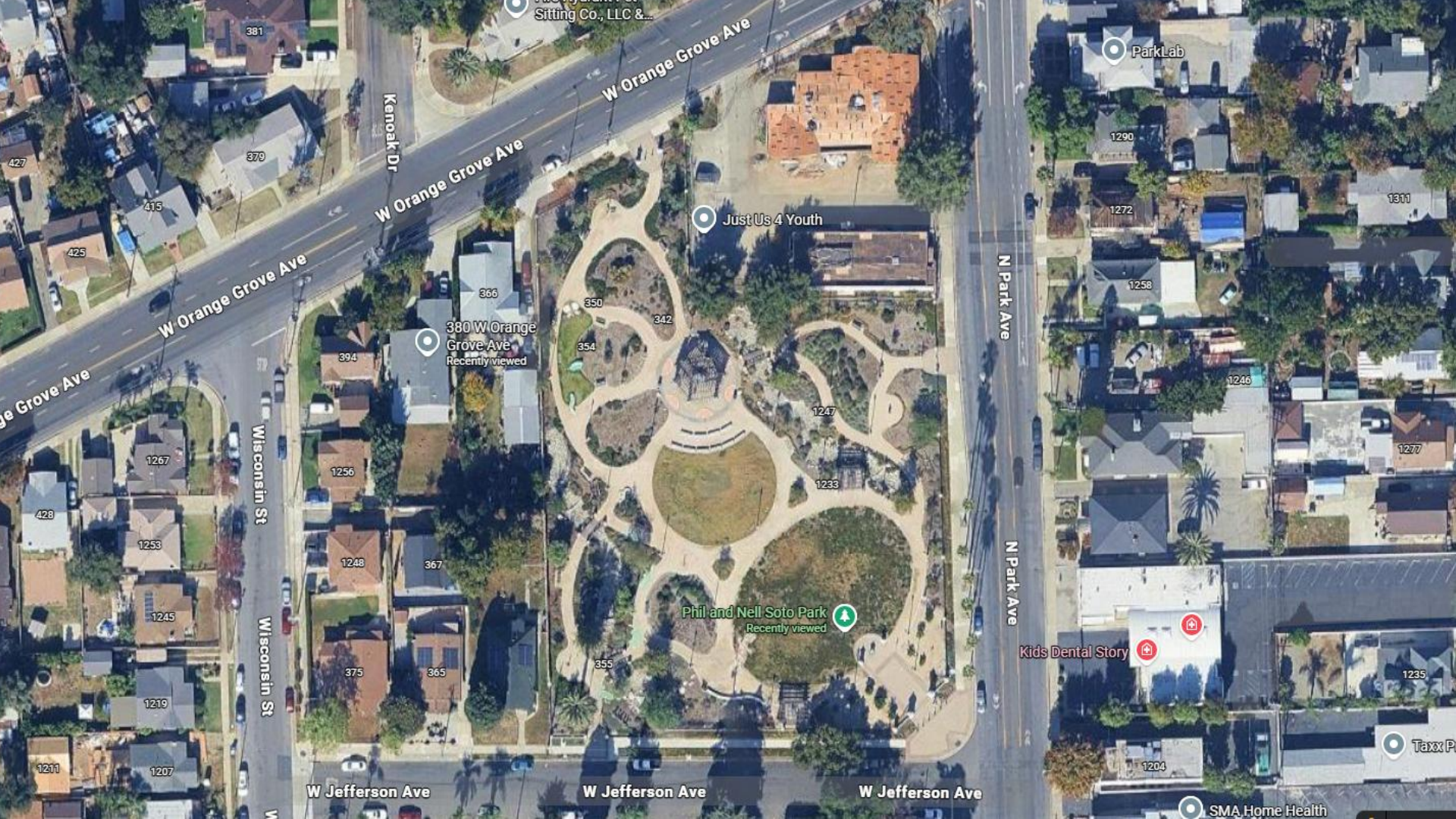

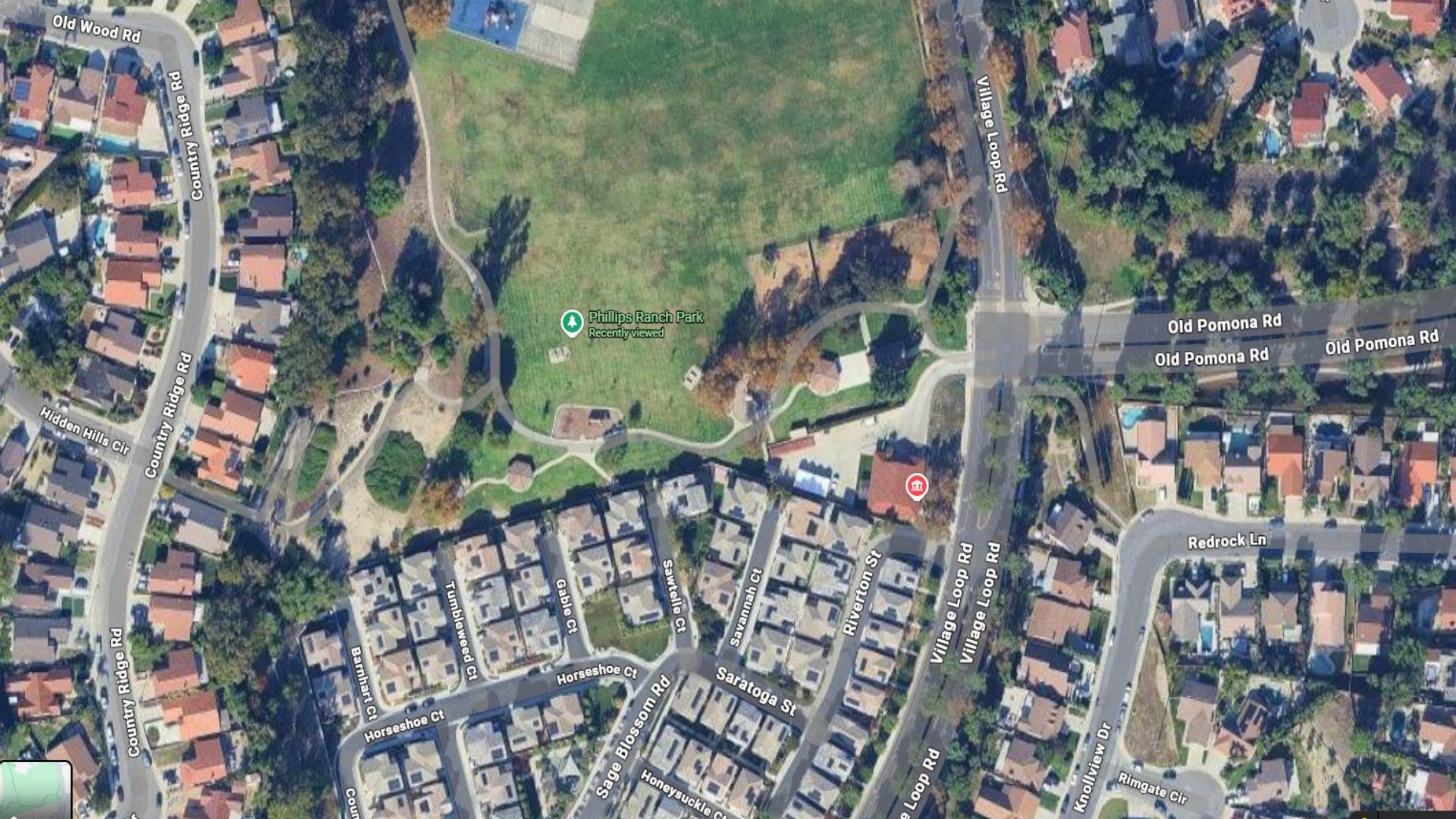

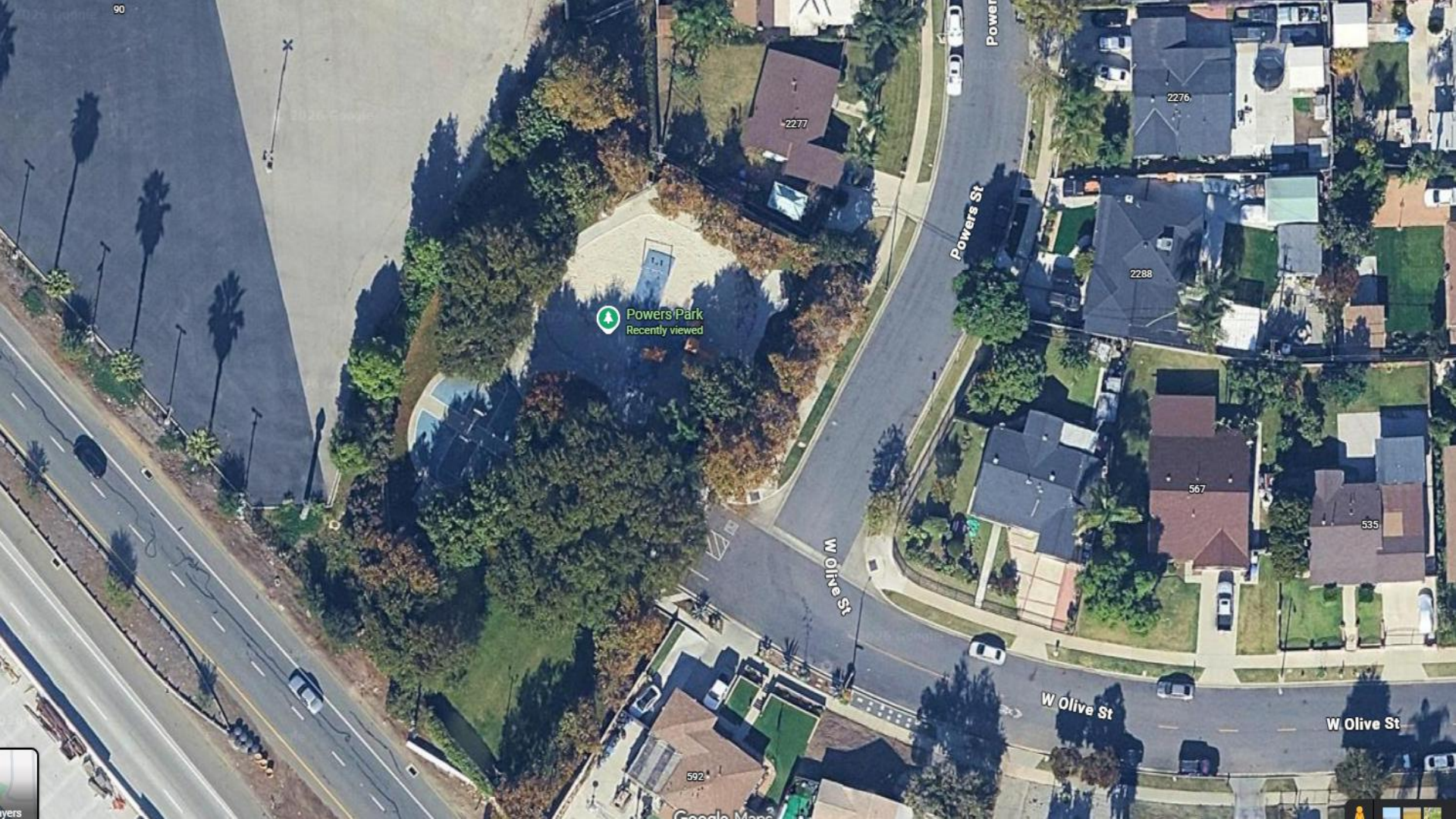
## P&R Commissioner Recommendations:

- Reader boards at key locations: Palomares, Washington, Ganesha, MLK
- Smart irrigation
- Flooring, painting, countertops and sinks at all centers
- Fix property boundaries
- Replace trash cans (new standard)
- Bench/table upgrade/additions and standardize
- Full field renovations
- Consider removal of free community libraries (little libraries)
- Install remaining dog waste stations
- Review trail system
- Citywide key system/badges
