

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-178**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, ADMENDING THE FY 2024-25 OPERATING BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,000**

**WHEREAS**, the State’s Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Mini Grant has been awarded to the City of Pomona to fund the Police Department’s efforts in addressing alcohol-related problems associated with alcoholic beverage licensed establishments. The performance period for this grant begins October 1, 2024 through August 31st, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the total amount of \$40,000 awarded to the Police Department will be used to conduct undercover operations, in conjunction with local ABC enforcement officers, on an overtime basis;

**WHEREAS**, the authority to accept an ABC Mini Grant and amend the FY 2024-25 Operating Budget by increasing revenue estimates and appropriations in the amount of \$40,000 is vested with the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby amends the FY 2024-25 Operating Budget by increasing revenue estimate (215-2090-40873-58801) and appropriations (215-2090-5XXXX-58801) in the amount of \$40,000.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into the Grant Agreement on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 3.** The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
