WORK FINISHED  
ON TWO HOUSES

Homes on Orange Grove, Randolph Built for Owners By Local Contractor

Two new Pomona residences, on Orange Grove avenue and on Randolph street, built for the owners by Martin J. Jaska, local building contractor, today were complete and occupied.

One is the home of Mr. and Mrs. Samuel J. Savage at 644 W. Orange Grove avenue, facing north on a lot 50x150 feet. It is complete, even to plantings around the house, and is now occupied by the owners.

Across the front of the house are the living room, dining room and breakfast nook, and adjoining it are a service porch and toilet and lavatory room. There are two bedrooms at the rear of the house, separated by the bathroom.

This, like the other newly completed house, is of California Monterey type, of frame stucco composition with wood shingle roof.

The other house was built by Jaska at 630 Randolph street, at the Hamilton boulevard corner, for Miss Frances Blanger, who has rented it. The entrance to this house, which is on a 50x150 foot lot, faces Randolph street, and the floor plan is a reverse of that in the other dwelling.

The living rooms in both houses have paneled and papered walls, with stucco ceilings. Both have floor furnaces.

Jaska, who has built a number of homes on N. Myrtle and other streets in Pomona, is now building a five-room ranch type home at Los Serranos for Floyd H. Cooper. It is to be completed about three weeks hence. An outstanding feature of this dwelling is an exterior finish of shadow shakes, which according to Jaska has not been used previously in this locality.

Other houses which Jaska is to start soon include a five-room home for Mr. and Mrs. George Spence at 835 N. Myrtle street, and a home in Ontario for J. R. Jaky. Subcontractors who furnished work and materials on the homes built by Jaska on Orange Grove and Randolph street include: E. J. Hall, plumbing and installation of De Luxe floor furnaces; Carl Morgan, wiring; L. W. Paulson, tile setting; P. Hernandez, cement and fireplaces; Putnam Hardwood Floor & Linoleum company, hardwood floors; Dutch Boy Paint store, furnished paint and enamel.

# Bookie Suspect Arrested in Raid

Pomona and Los Angeles county sheriff's vice squad officers swooped down on a home at 835 N. Myrtle avenue yesterday at 1:10 p. m. to arrest George Spence, 55, on a bookmaking charge, Chief of Police Ralph Parker said today.

Parker said investigators received several bets over the phone while on the raid and that Spence's scratch sheets, betting markers and other bookie paraphernalia was seized for evidence.

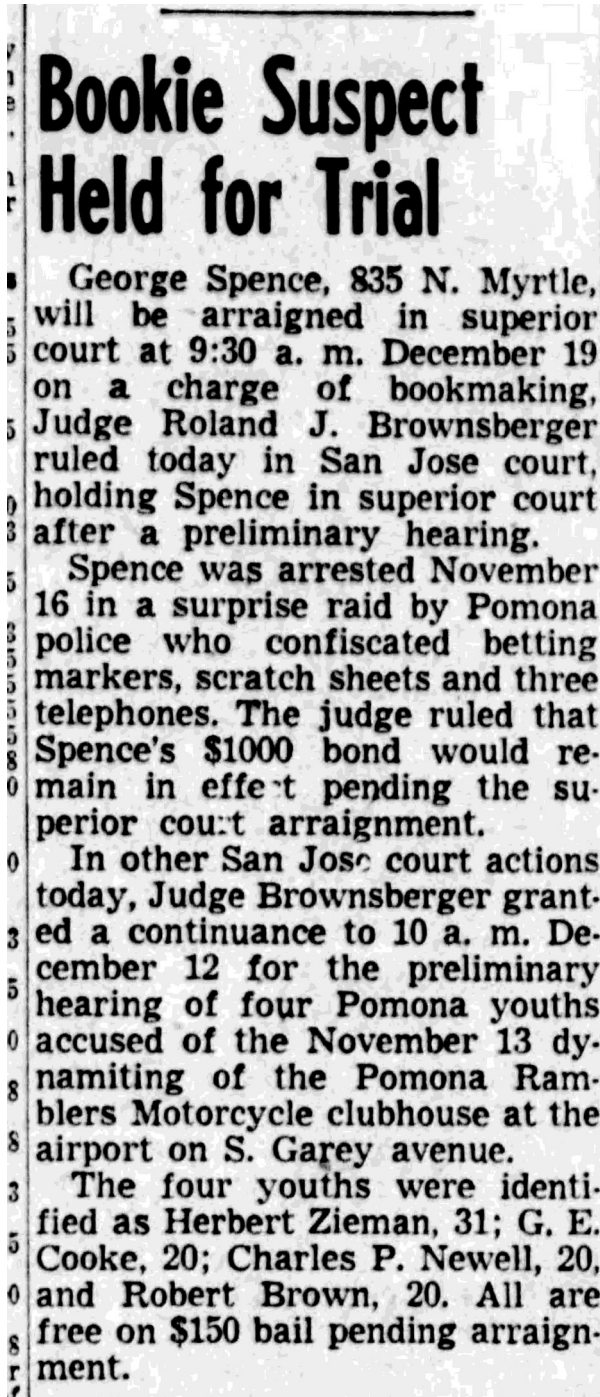
Spence was arrested under the terms of the state code in violation of Sec. 330A and the chief said the man apparently relayed bets to points in San Bernardino county thru his phone.
