SUBJECT: DESIGNATE A VOTING DELEGATE AND ALTERNATE(S) FOR THE

2025 LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES ANNUAL CONFERENCE

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council take the following actions:

- 1) Designate a voting delegate and voting alternate(s) for the 2025 League of California Cities Annual Conference scheduled to take place on October 8-10, 2025; and
- 2) Direct Staff to complete the Voting Delegate Form through the League of California Cities online submission portal (Attachment No. 1).

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Appointment of a voting delegate and alternate(s) must be made each year in order to take part in the voting at the General Assembly. In addition to a voting delegate, the City Council may also appoint up to two alternate voting delegates, one of whom may vote in the event that the designated delegate is unable to serve in that capacity.
