PARK NAMING POLICY OVERVIEW AND CRITERIA

- Park Naming Process:
 - Initiated at Parks & Recreation Commission
 - Community Meeting
 - Recommendation at Parks & Recreation Commission
 - City Council
- Park Naming Criteria:
 - Reflect geographic location or local/national heritage
 - Honor individuals with 20+ years of community service in Pomona
 - Recognize major financial contributors (individuals or businesses)
 - Acknowledge organizations funding ongoing maintenance
 - May honor City employees under extraordinary circumstances
 - May not promote harm or inappropriate content

PHILLIPS RANCH GREENBELT

- Action of City Council to convert to City park effective July 1, 2025.
- Area extending from Country Crossing Park, bounded by Village Loop Road and Falcon Ridge Drive, terminating at Phillips Ranch Road.
- Over 15 acres open green space with paved walking path.
- Portion of Parcourse equipment replaced April 2025



CIVIC CENTER PLAZA PARK

- Under development, anticipated opening early 2026
 - Will be largest all-abilities playground in City of Pomona
 - Includes other amenities such as restroom facilities and restored fountain

MEADOWVIEW DEMONSTRATION GARDEN

- Constructed along Meadow View Dr
- One-of-a-kind park in the City
- Includes native, drought-tolerant plants and trees, water-wise irrigation, pathways, and seating/viewing areas.

- Community meetings to be held at each park location in July (once dates are confirmed, outreach will be conducted)
- Nomination period will close in August and park name suggestions meeting criteria will be brought before Parks & Recreation Commission in September for vote.
- Recommendations from Parks & Recreation Commission will go to City Council for final consideration and official park naming.
