RESOLUTION NO. 2026-15 – A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 GENERAL FUND BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES BY A TOTAL OF \$2,000 ANNUALLY FOR EVCS CHARGING STATIONS AT PALOMARES PARK

WHEREAS, the Pomona City Charter requires that amendments to the Adopted Budget be approved by resolution, with approval of the Pomona City Council;

WHEREAS, the City of Pomona (“City”) and EV Charging Solutions, Inc. (EVCS), (collectively referred to as “Parties”) entered into a site host agreement on September 5, 2024, to install and operate Level II electric vehicle charging stations at Palomares Park;

WHEREAS, Parties wish to share the revenue received from utilization of the charging stations at Palomares Park for 10 years after commissioning date (October 2025).

WHEREAS, EVCS will determine the rate for use of electric vehicle charging equipment, and will pay City \$0.03 for each kWh of electricity sold to customers;

WHEREAS, if the total quarterly amount owed to City is less than one hundred dollars (\$100), then EVCS may choose to withhold payment until at least \$100 us due to City;

WHEREAS, City will provide electricity bills, or access to said electric bills, on an ongoing basis from the meter providing electricity to the electric vehicle charging equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the FY 2025-26 General Fund revenue budget to increase revenue estimates by \$2,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-2026 General Fund revenue budget, by increasing revenue estimates by \$2,000 annually to FD101, General Fund | CC9999, All Non-Departmental; RC 277 EV Charging Stations Revenue; PG 168| EVCS EV Station, for the EV Charging stations located at Palomares Park.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
