RESOLUTION NO. 2026-16 – A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 WATER FUND BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS BY \$3,000 FOR CHARGEPOINT CHARGING STATIONS FOR THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Pomona City Charter requires that amendments to the Adopted Budget be approved by resolution, with approval of the Pomona City Council;

WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department installed five electric vehicle charging stations during the construction of the new Water Resources building in 2024.

WHEREAS, City fleet utilizes three of the charging stations, and two charging stations are used by employees on a pay for use basis; and

WHEREAS, City staff desire to amend the FY 2025-26 Water Fund budget to increase revenue estimates and appropriations by \$3,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-2026 Water Fund Revenue budget, by increasing revenue estimates by \$3,000 FD571, Water Fund | CC8110, Water Operations | RC277 EV Charging Station Revenue | PG169 ChargePoint EV Station and appropriating funds to FD571, Water Fund | CC8122, Maintenance and Operations | Dues Subscription and Certificates | PG169 ChargePoint EV Station and \$7,498 from FD571, Water Fund | CC8122, Maintenance and Operations | Other Expenses | PG169 ChargePoint EV Station.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution, and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
