SUBJECT: APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF PICKUP TRUCKS AND UTILITY

TRUCKS FOR THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council take the following actions:

1) Approve the purchase of seven (7) Ford Lightning pickup trucks in the amount of \$506,520 from Transwest Truck Centers; and,

2) Approve the purchase of one Ford F-250 utility truck, one Ford F-350 and one Ford F-550 utility truck in the total amount of \$270,646 from Ted Jones Ford, Inc.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The recommended actions will approve the purchase of a total of 10 trucks for the Water Resources Department (WRD). Of the 10 new trucks, 6 will replace existing trucks that meet the City's vehicle replacement policy and 4 are new to the WRD fleet. The addition of these 4 trucks will meet the WRD's daily operations workload demands.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The total fiscal impact for the proposed action is \$777,166. Funding is available within the FY 2024-25 Water Operating Budget account number 571-8122-66182-00000 (\$566,655) and Sewer Operating Budget 581-2522-66182-00000 (\$210,511); funding was approved by City Council as part of the supplemental budget requests.

#### PREVIOUS RELATED ACTION:

On February 26, 2024, City Council approved the purchase of two utility trucks from National Auto Fleet Group (NAFG). The 2 utility trucks were intended to replace utility trucks that are utilized daily by the WRD, Water Production division.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The recommended action will authorize the purchase of ten utility trucks for the department as described in Table 1 and Table 2 below. NAFG was unable to fulfill the order due to limitations in the supply of materials utilized in the production of their utility trucks. In September 2024, the two Purchase Orders that was issued by the City for procurement of the utility trucks were cancelled. After assessing the vehicle needs for the department, staff is recommending the purchase of 1 Ford F-350 utility truck and 2 Ford Lightning pickup trucks. The recommendation will aid the City with the California Air Resources Board compliance standards.

All 6 vehicles in Table 1 meet the replacement requirements listed in the Vehicle Replacement Policy and/or fulfill the needs of the department. The replacement recommendation is based on excessive wear and tear, continuous repairs needed and maintenance costs.

Table 2 the following provides a list of new additions to the (non-replacement) trucks to the City's fleet. The four trucks will be used daily for normal operations and are necessary for the continued department operations.

Pricings for the trucks were obtained by utilizing quotes from contacting dealerships based on availability. Purchasing has reviewed the bid process presenting at minimum three quotes for each vehicle provided by dealerships and recommends the purchase using Transwest Truck Centers and Ted Jones Ford Inc. Table 3 below presents all quotes received and results ranking.
