Staff Update

Staff recommends to the Cultural Arts Commission to approve the maintenance award of \$767.52 for Artist Ruben Young, a.k.a. Grey Matter, ("The Artist") to coat his six murals.

Background

The Cultural Arts Commission ("The Commission") approved the Artist to carry out six mural projects through the Call for Visual Arts 2022 at the August 8th, 2023 Commission meeting. The Artist had not included in his budget the cost of coating his murals with the UV/Graffiti coatings. Attached is the requested amount of funding.
