#### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

1. Conditional Use Permit (CUP-000104-2025) for 1518 N. Garey Avenue.

Senior Planner Jimenez presented the item.

- 1. Request to allow the sale of alcohol beverages (Off-Sale Beer and Wine Type 20) for off-site consumption in conjunction with an existing convenience market and gas station.
- 2. This site went through the entitlement process in 1983, and everything is permitted and up to code
- 3. The applicant did apply for a CUP for the sale of alcohol beverages in 2005. Planning Commission approved the Conditional Use Permit. However, City Council denied the request due to finding of public convenience and necessity.
- 4. Informed the Commission of the number alcohol licenses issued by Alcohol Beverage Control in the subject census tract
- 5. The census tract is eligible for an additional off sale alcohol license and the additional license will not exceed the number of licenses permitted in the subject census tract
- 6. City Council will need to make a finding of public convenience and necessity
- 7. CEQA, Class 1 categorical exemption, Section 15301 (existing facilities)
- 8. Recommends approval of CUP-000104-2025, subject to conditions

#### Commission concerns/questions

- Commissioner Camacho asked staff about the specific condition for revocation of a Conditional Use Permit
- 2. Commissioner Chu asked if the EV charging stations are operating and what is the closest supermarket
- 3. Commissioner Beans asked if he needed to recuse himself due to owning properties nearby
- 4. Commissioner Chu had concerns about the number of alcohol licenses issued in the general vicinity
- 5. Commissioner Beans mentioned that he is familiar with this gas station and believes the owner is a responsible operator
- 6. Commissioner Camacho stated that he is having difficulty making a finding of public convenience and necessity
- 7. Chairperson Molina had concerns about the rise of DUIs in the city and the proximity to the freeway
- 8. Commissioner Martin-Marshall stated that there are a lot of checkpoints near this gas station
- 9. Commissioner Chu asked staff if they are aware of the total Beer and Wine Type 20 licenses issued by Alcohol Beverage Control
