Fruit Packed Here in 1906 In Cartons

When and where were oranges packed in cardboard cartons? In 1906, in a long since burned-down Pomona packing house at 1st and Eleanor street.

The question was answered when the picture of the old packing house, published May 3 in The Progress-Bulletin, stirred recollections in the minds of at least three Pomona valley residents, who wrote letters as requested to Mutual Orange Distributors.

The 45-year-old photo was recognized at once by Mrs. Clyde Ades of 1844 Frances street, Chino, and by Mrs. Edith C. Neher of 906 N. Palomares street and Thomas Brosman of 601 E. 4th street, both Pomona, all of whom worked at the packing house when the picture was taken in 1906.

They all identified the packing house as that of the old California Produce company, which subsequently burned down.

Spectator Identified

It was located at 1st and Eleanor streets, site of the present-day Orange Belt Fruit Distributors, a packing plant affiliated with MOD.

Brosman recognized himself standing in the line of spectators watching five women pack oranges in cardboard cartons labeled "Golden Beauties." Both Mrs. Ades and Mrs. Neher recalled that they were in the packing line at the time, altho they do not appear in the picture.

Manager of the packing house was identified as Dave Andrews, one of the derby-hatted spectators. Others identified in the spectator line were Albert Smith, Percy Burck and Jim Perry.

Thomas Brosman of Pomona recognized himself in the line of spectators. Mrs. Edith C. Neher of Pomona and Mrs. Clyde Ades of Chino, who also worked at the packing house, do not appear in the picture but recognized it at once.

Packers in the picture were identified as Mrs. Winnie Orem, a Mrs. Barnes, a Miss Doty, Mayme Myers and Frances Henry. Several of those in the picture have since died.

Allan Break of Bryn Mawr, who was active in the citrus industry in Pomona at the turn of the century, recalls that the firm was started by a group of independent growers.

Cartons Put in Crates

Mrs. Neher recalls that the cartons being packed were a consumer package containing a dozen oranges. The packers assembled the cartons before packing them. The packages then were crated, six to eight packages in a wooden crate.

Brosman remembers that Golden Beauties were the house's second grand brand. The major brand was called Wedding Bells. None of the informants could shed any light on why the carton experiment was discontinued after a couple of years.

Mutual Orange Distributors' interest in obtaining data on the picture was due to the cooperative's current experiment of packing oranges in fiberboard cartons holding half as much as a standard box.

They thought they were the first to try it in California—until the old picture turned up in the effects of the late Mrs. Isaac Hitchcock, mother of Mrs. Harry Mount of 437 E. Alvarado avenue, Pomona.

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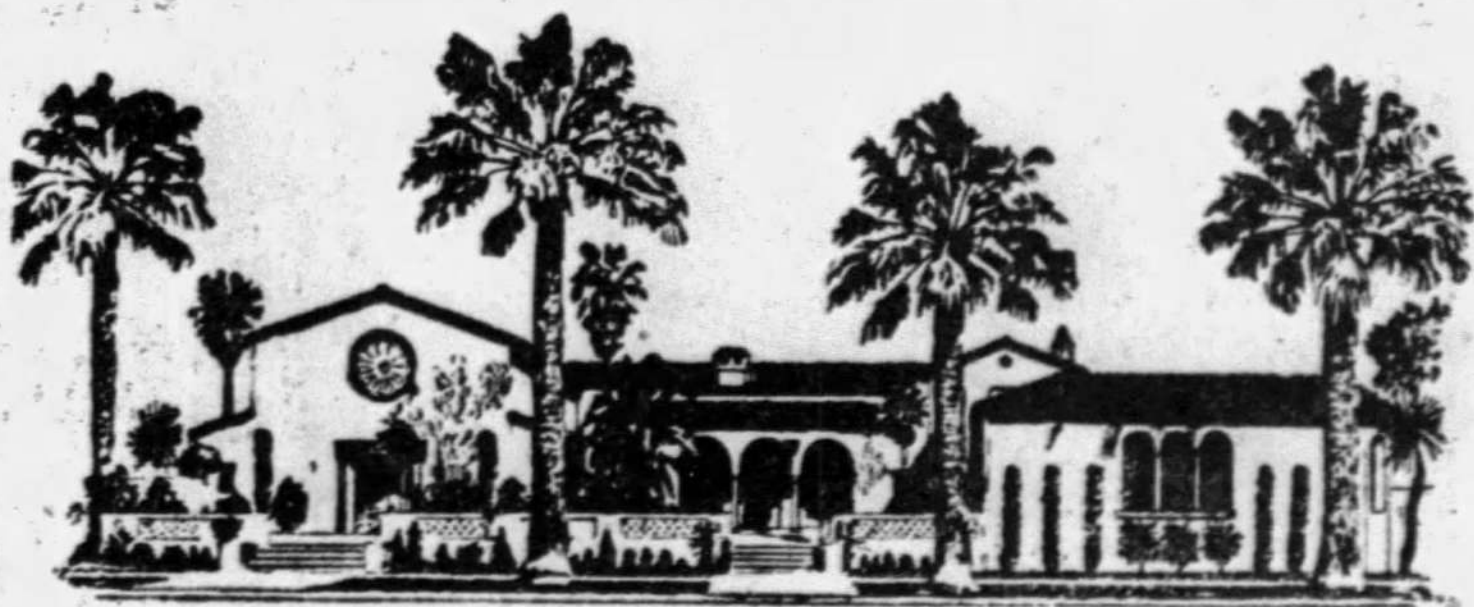

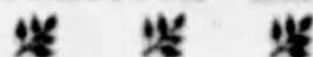
