**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA,
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 SPECIAL OPERATING BUDGET
TO INCREASE REVENUE ESTIMATES AND APPROPRIATIONS BY \$20,000**

WHEREAS, the Police Department has been awarded a Motorcycle Safety Education and Training Program Grant from the Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) in the amount of \$20,000;

WHEREAS, the Motorcycle Safety Education and Training Program Grant has been awarded to fund the Pomona Police Department's efforts to teach defensive riding and simulate scenarios reduce the number of persons injured and motorcycle related incidents beginning October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026;

WHEREAS, the Police Department will coordinate educational campaigns for Motorcycle Safety Month;

WHEREAS, the authority to accept the Motorcycle Safety Education and Training Program Grant and amend the current FY 2025-26 Special Operating Budgets by increasing revenue and appropriations in the amount of \$20,000 is vested with City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby amends the FY 2025-26 Special Operating Budget by increasing revenue estimate (215-2014-40875-58824) and appropriations (215-2014-5XXXX-58824) in the amount of \$20,000.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all agreements on behalf of the City, in substantially the form submitted, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That City Clerk shall attest to and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
