SUBJECT: RATIFICATION OF THE SALE OF FIVE (5) NEW VEHICLE PARKING PERMITS ISSUED IN APRIL AND MAY 2026

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Parking Place Commissioners approve the ratification of five (5) new vehicle parking permits issued in April and May 2026.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

To ensure timely processing of VPD parking permit sales, the VPD Commission has authorized staff to issue permits to qualified applicants immediately upon receipt of their application and payment. The Commission's action formalizes and ratifies the issuance of these permits.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The VPD received a total of \$285 for the sale of five (5) new parking permits.

DISCUSSION:

As the sale of parking permits involves public funds, the VPD Commission must ratify the issuance of each new permit. This ensures transparency, impartiality, and provides a documented record of active VPD parking permits. During this reporting period, five (5) new parking permits were sold in April and May 2026. A summary of new parking permits issued can be found below.

Residential Parking Permits

1. Luis Castillo – Issued 4/1/26
2. Brittney Price – Issued 4/16/26
3. Jay Sanchez – Issued 4/22/26
4. Steven Auld – Issued 4/30/26

Lot Specific Permits

5. Diana Do – Issued 4/20/26

Renewals of existing parking permits do not require additional ratification beyond the approval of the initial issuance and ratification by the Commission. These purchases are documented in the parking inventory summary sheet (Attachment No. 1), which details the available spaces in each VPD parking lot, the number of permits issued, and the number of permit holders who did not renew for information only.

If new permits have been issued, corresponding applications are included as Attachment No. 2. At present, there is sufficient parking to accommodate the additional permit holders.
