1. Definition of Ethics

"What is generally called the 'ethics' of the profession is but consensus of expert opinion as the necessity of professional standards." (Black's Law Dictionary)

2. Legal Ethics

"Usages and customs among members of the legal profession, involving their moral and professional duties toward one another." (Black's Law Dictionary)

3. General

"1. A system of moral principles.

2. The rules of conduct recognized in respect to a particular class of human actions or particular group culture.

3. Moral principles of an individual.

4. The branch of philosophy dealing with values relating to human conduct with respect to the rightness and wrongness of certain actions and to the goodness and badness of the motives and ends of such actions." (Random House College Dictionary)
