


Variable	Abbreviation	Averaging Period	AQI Value	AQI Description	AQI Color Code	Meaning
Ozone	O <sub>3</sub>	8-hr	46	Good		Air quality is considered satisfactory, and air pollution poses little or no risk.
Fine Particulate Matter	PM <sub>2.5</sub>	24-hr	55	Moderate		Air quality is acceptable; however, for some pollutants there may be a moderate health concern for a very small number of people. For example, people who are unusually sensitive to ozone may experience respiratory symptoms.
Particulate Matter	PM <sub>10</sub> B	24-hr	24	Good		Air quality is considered satisfactory, and air pollution poses little or no risk.
Nitrogen Dioxide	NO <sub>2</sub>	24-hr	5	Good		Air quality is considered satisfactory, and air pollution poses little or no risk.
Carbon Monoxide	СО	8-hr	5	Good		Air quality is considered satisfactory, and air pollution poses little or no risk.

On May 15, 2008, AQMD began forecasting and reporting in the 8-hour ozone air quality standard, as adopted by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The 1-hour standard reflects the more stringent state standard
