### THEME

This year's theme is where do we find or see "Boundless Culture & Creativity: The Essence of Freedom" with a sub-theme of "Building Joy, Action + Power" in Pomona. This theme is to honor April as the state's designated Arts, Culture, and Creativity Month theme by [CA for the Arts](#).

### SCHEDULE

#### Contest Opens

**Tuesday, January 27, 2026**

#### Contest Deadline

**March 23, 2026, by 6PM**

Artwork and supplemental materials must be received on or before the deadline at the Office of Economic & Business Affairs at City Hall (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor), 505 S Garey Avenue, Pomona, CA 91769.

#### Artwork Judging

**March 24 – March 30, 2026**

Artwork judging will be done by a selected group of artists familiar with the watercolor medium.

#### Awards Notifications

**Tuesday, March 31, 2026**

All winners will be announced via email to all student and teacher information provided on the application.

#### Exhibition and Reception

**Friday, April 10, 2026, at 6PM**

Reception will take place at the dA Center for the Arts, located at 252 #D S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Pomona, CA 91766.

#### Artwork Pick-Up for Awardees

**May 4 – 7, 2026, open from 7:30AM - 6PM**

Artwork selected will be returned to artists after exhibit closes and available to be picked up at City Hall.

### CRITERIA & SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

The following contest is open to public and private High School students, as well as students who live in and/or are home-schooled, in Pomona, CA. All entries shall follow the theme of this year's Watercolor contest and be of the **watercolor medium ONLY**, use of any other medium will result in disqualification. In order to be considered all artists shall submit the following:

- 1. Application.** All submissions shall include a completed and signed application.
- 2. Artwork.** All submitted artwork must be representative of the theme and shall meet the following dimensions: 11"x14" (matted on a white 16"x20" mat). Framed artwork will NOT be accepted.
- 3. Artist Statement.** The Artist statement should include a brief paragraph explaining the meaning /motivation behind the artwork. Artist statement shall be attached to the application form.
