RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council receive and file the Police Oversight Commission Annual Report.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Ordinance No. 4303, Section 2-655 ("Duties and Responsibilities") directed the Police Oversight Commission to "prepare and submit an annual report to the City Council concerning the Commission's activities."

DISCUSSION:

The Police Oversight Commission ("Commission"), established by Ordinance No. 4303, began its regular monthly meetings in December 2021. At the June 2022 meeting, the Commission voted to create an ad-hoc committee to develop a 12-month work plan. This ad-hoc committee would also work on preparing the required annual report. At the April 2023 Police Oversight Commission meeting, Commission Chair Eric Vasquez presented the draft annual report to the Commission and at subsequent meetings; the Commission discussed the finalization of this report to be presented to the City Council.
