City Firm To Get Chance at Missile Pact

General Dynamics Pomona is one of three firms awarded a system definition phase contract for the AIM-82 short range missile program, the Air Force announced. This is the first step in the Air Force's plan to develop a new air-to-air guided missile to be carried primarily by the new F-15 superiority fighter. The system definition phase work, to be done under a \$1,147,747 contract, will be completed within three months. This will lead to a competitive bid for actual development of the missile, scheduled to be awarded in late summer.
