SUBJECT: ACCEPT A DONATION FROM COUNCILMEMBER LUSTRO (DISTRICT 5) AND ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS FOR THE RESTRIPING OF COUNTRY CROSSINGS PARK PARKING LOT

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-17, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$1,965 FROM COUNCILMEMBER LUSTRO (DISTRICT 5) AND AMENDING THE FY 2025-26 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCREASE REVENUE ESTIMATES BY \$1,965 AND APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS TO FD101, GENERAL FUND | CC2562, PAINT AND SIGN | CONTROLLABLE CONTRACT SERVICES FOR THE RESTRIPING OF COUNTRY CROSSINGS PARK PARKING LOT

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Adoption of Resolution No. 2026-17 will allow Staff to accept a personal donation from District 5 Councilmember Steve Lustro and appropriate the funds to cover costs for the restriping of Country Crossings Park parking lot.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Adoption of Resolution No. 2026-17 will increase revenue estimates in the amount of \$1,965 and appropriate those funds in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Operating Budget in FD101, General Fund | CC2562, Paint and Sign | Controllable Contract Services.

DISCUSSION:

Councilmember Lustro requested that Staff obtain cost estimates for restriping the parking lot at Country Crossings Park following a complaint regarding improper parking associated with organized soccer activities. The Councilmember personally inspected the site and observed vehicles parked along curbs obstructing circulation and a vehicle parked within landscaped areas. Public Works also inspected the parking lot and agreed that restriping the lot would improve conditions.

Staff obtained three quotes for the restriping work. Councilmember Lustro has offered to donate funds equal to the lowest-cost quote to fully cover the cost. Adoption of Resolution No. 2026-17 will accept the donation from Councilmember Lustro and appropriate these funds to allow the improvements to be completed without impact on City funds and help address the identified parking and access concerns at Country Crossings Park.
