Suggestions:

- At the bottom of the table include definitions for fields like: Inc. Incident type; Alg. Allegation; Inc. Status; and Inc. Disposition. Including these definitions can help non-experts better understand the data and make POC meetings more accessible to the public.
- For incidents in "Initial" status, flag whether steps have been taken by the police department in response to the incident.

Community Events:

On a regular basis (maybe quarterly) we should have some presentation/conversation about the community events and how they are meeting PD objectives.

- Purpose of the events: What goals the PD set (increase positive contacts, educate youth on safety, etc.)
- Participating units
- Activities conducted: workshops, presentations, resource sharing, etc.
- Reach: Who attended? Was this the intended population for the event?
- Community feedback - what did the community raise during the meetings
- Outcomes/impact - What changed because of the event. Were the goals of the event achieved? How so?
- Action items/next steps - How is PD using information/experiences from this event to inform their work moving forward?

PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS:

- Suggested fields to add
 - Investigations by police beat: Reporting incidents by location such as police beats can help to identify patterns across the city
 - Incident Dispositions for closed investigations

Crime statistics:

- Arrests overall and by crime category
 - Total number or arrests
 - Comparison to same period last year
 - Breakdown by:
 - Felony, misdemeanor
 - Arrests by offense type:
 - Violent, property, drug-related, weapons offenses, DUI, Disorder, Warrants
 - Number of arrests for each category
 - Comparison to same period last year
 - Type of police contact leading to arrest

- Officer-initiated
 - Citizen call for service
 - Traffic stop
 - Community policing activity
 - Special operation
 - Outcome (overall and by arrest type)
 - Booked into jail
 - Cited and released
 - Comparison to same period last year
 - Force used?
 - Number of arrests involving use of force
 - Comparison to same period last year
 - Arrest demographics
 - Age groups
 - Gender
 - Race/ethnicity
 - Residency

 - Request types
 - Year over year trends
 - Geographic breakdowns
