b) When called upon, the person shall stand, state his/her name and address for the record, and if speaking for an organization or other group, identify the organization or

group represented. Whenever any group or persons wishes to address the Parks and Recreation Commission on the same subject matter, the Chair may, at his/her discretion, request that the group choose a spokesperson to address the Commission.

c) All remarks should be addressed to the Parks and Recreation Commission as a whole, and not to individual Commissioners. Questions, if any, should be directed to the presiding Chair who will determine whether, or in what manner, an answer will be provided.

d) Every person addressing the Parks and Recreation Commission will be limited to three (3) minutes or such reasonable time as is granted by the majority of the Parks and Recreation Commission.
