- c. By using the "Q&A" button during the meeting for written comments (limited to 200 words). All comments must be submitted at the beginning of the public comment section.
- d. If you are participating via phone only, use *9 to "Raise your hand" and *6 to unmute or mute yourself when called to speak.

Please be aware that the meeting will be conducted via webinar format and the Commission will not be able to see the audience, only hear them.

All requests to speak must be submitted at the beginning of public comment.
