SUBJECT: SECOND READING AND ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE AMENDING

POMONA CITY CODE SECTIONS 58-676 (18) AND 58-679 (A) AND (B) PERTAINING TO EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS AND THE

ROTATION SYSTEM FOR CITY TOW FRANCHISEES

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 4318 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING POMONA CITY CODE SECTIONS 58-676 (18) AND 58-679 (A) AND (B) PERTAINING TO EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS AND THE ROTATION SYSTEM FOR CITY TOW FRANCHISEES

#### **DISCUSSION:**

This ordinance was first introduced at the July 18, 2022 City Council Meeting (Attachment No. 1). The purpose of proposed Ordinance No. 4318 (Attachment No. 2) is to amend Pomona City Codes 58-676(18) and 58-679(a) and (b) to require city tow franchisees to have vehicles capable of "heavy-duty" towing, that a second rotation system be created for "heavy-duty" tows to ensure equity amongst city tow franchisees, and that the option to refuse response and forfeit rotation position be removed. These amendments will facilitate Ordinance No. 4315.

The ordinance will take effect 30 days after its adoption on August 1, 2022.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.
