

2022 Public Health Goals Report for Drinking Water

The Pomona City Council invites the community to attend a Public Hearing concerning the 2022 Public Health Goals Report for drinking water. California Health and Safety Code 116470(b) require water utility agencies serving more than 10,000 connections to prepare this report every three years. The Public Health Goals are intended to guide the establishment of future drinking water regulations.

The City of Pomona's drinking water system continues to meet or exceed all U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and State Water Resources Control Board's drinking water standards. The purpose of presenting this report in a public hearing is to provide water system customers greater access to information on levels of constituents and provide the opportunity for comment on the Public Health Goals Report.

The 2022 Public Health Goals Report is available for public inspection at the City Clerk's Office at 505 South Garey Avenue, Pomona, California 91766, from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday. In addition, copies may be obtained by contacting the City Clerk's Office at (909) 620-2341. Any person desiring to make comments or present information to the City Council may make an oral presentation at the Public Hearing or submit written comments for the City Council's consideration by delivering them to the City Clerk's Office before the time of the hearing.
