## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, TO ESTABLISH A PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT ON STANTON STREET, JAYSON COURT, REX COURT, AND STERLING STREET AND FINDING OF EXTREME HARDSHIP AND WAIVER OF PERMIT FEE

**WHEREAS**, non-resident and an oversaturation of residential parking on Stanton Street, between Harrison Avenue and Edwin Avenue, in the City of Pomona, is causing extreme hardship among the residents of adjacent dwelling units and negatively impacting their quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, the oversaturation of parked vehicles on Stanton Street, between Harrison Avenue and Edwin Avenue, has resulted in increased litter, incomplete street sweeping, and a lack of on-street parking for residents and their guests; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Pomona Municipal Code Section 58-239, the City Council may establish a Preferential Parking District which will address resident concerns; and

**WHEREAS**, the City mailed notices to the affected residents in advance of the Public Hearing as required by Pomona Municipal Code Section 58-239; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council on its own motion after considering public testimony, may establish a Preferential Parking District, and

**WHEREAS,** to avoid an undue burden and financial hardship on residents within the Preferential Parking District, the City Council has authority pursuant to Pomona Municipal Code Section 2-4 to waive the permit fees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby establishes the Preferential Parking District as shown in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, consisting of two phases:

Phase 1 - Stanton Street between Harrison Avenue and Edwin Avenue (to be implemented immediately upon approval);

Phase 2 - Sterling Street, Jayson Court, and Rex Court (to be implemented at the request of local residents with a signed petition showing min. 75% support) if there is observable parking spillover onto these adjacent streets.

**<u>SECTION 2.</u>** The City Council hereby makes a finding of extreme hardship and waives the permit fee for this Preferential Parking District.


