

Dear Pomona City Council Members,


My name is Yesenia Miranda Meza an active member of our community. I am a volunteer with several organizations and a proud resident in our beautiful City of Pomona.

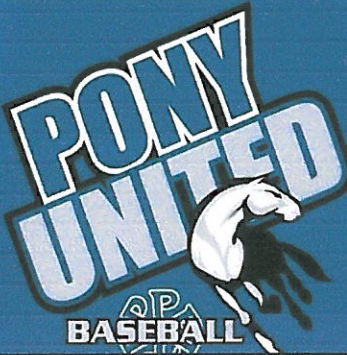
