Selection of Chair and Vice-Chair

BACKGROUND:

Chair Saul Roque has served as Chair of the Community Life Commission a little over one year. Due to the recent election, the seat for Vice-Chair has been vacated, hence, the need for the Commission to vote for a new Vice-Chair. Per the By-Laws, the term of the Chair and Vice Chair shall be one (1) year. Two (2) consecutive terms may be served at the pleasure of the Commission. The By-Laws also require that the Chair and Vice Chair have served on the Commission for at least one (1) year or may elect a member desirous of being an officer who has served on the Commission for less than (1) year provided there is a six-sevenths (6/7) vote in favor of electing the member.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Commission has the following options as to which Commissioners are eligible to serve as **Chair:**

- A) Saul Roque Continue to serve as Chair for the CLC for one more term; has served on the Commission over two (2) years, one of which was served as Chair.
- B) Alfredo Camacho-Gonzalez has served on the Commission approximately one (1) year and nine (9) months.
- C) Elect a member desirous of being an officer who has served on the Commission for less than one (1) year provided there is a six out of seven vote in favor of electing the member.

The CLC has the following options as to which Commissioner is/are eligible to serve as **Vice-Chair:**

- A) Saul Roque-Continue to serve as Chair for the CLC for one more term; has served on the Commission over two (2) years, one of which was served as Chair.
- B) Alfredo Camacho-Gonzalez has served on the Commission for approximately one (1) year and nine (9) months
- C) Elect a member desirous of being an officer who has served on the Commission for less than one (1) year provided there is a six out of seven vote in favor of electing the member.
