Subject: **Adoption of a Resolution Canceling the April 16, 2018 City Council Meeting Due to a Scheduling Conflict and Rescheduling the Meeting to Monday, April 23, 2018 to be conducted as a “Regular” Meeting of the City Council**

OVERVIEW

Recommendation – That the City Council adopt the attached proposed Resolution Canceling the April 16, 2018 regular City Council Meeting and rescheduling it to April 23, 2018 to be conducted as a regular meeting

Fiscal Impact – None with this action.

Previous Related Action – At the City Council Meeting on March 19, 2018 the City Council requested that staff reschedule the April 16th Council Meeting to Monday April 23rd due to a scheduling conflict.

DISCUSSION

Resolution number 2004-32 established that regular City Council meetings were to be held on the first and third Mondays of each month and study sessions were to be held, as needed, on the second Monday of each month. City Council meetings are rescheduled, as needed, to accommodate holidays and other conflicts. At the Meeting on March 19, 2018, the Mayor indicated that he had scheduled travel conflicting with the regularly scheduled meeting for April 16, 2018. The City Council agreed to cancel and reschedule the Meeting to Monday, April 23, 2018. The attached resolution would establish the newly rescheduled Meeting as a “regular” Meeting of the City Council to allow for Agenda placement and Council consideration of all City matters, including approval of items that are restricted, by City Code or Charter, for consideration at “regularly scheduled meetings” of the Council.
