The Y will continue the core programs that are currently serving our local communities. We are strengthening our Maple Hill, Preschool and Afterschool programs located in Diamond Bar. We added an afterschool site at Decker Elementary last August and will open one at Pantera Elementary this coming August. All afterschool sites are currently located at PUSD schools.

The Y of OC is a strong YMCA with extensive management experience that has the knowledge and resources to assist struggling YMCAs recover from hardships and re-build to meet the local community needs.
