A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF THE STREET PROJECTS LISTS AND THE PUBLIC WORKS OPERATION PROGRAM PLAN TO THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR RMRA/SB-1 FUNDING

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB-1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by Governor Brown in April 2017, in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide;

WHEREAS, SB-1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Pomona are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the City of Pomona must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB-1 by Resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement;

WHEREAS, the City of Pomona will receive an estimated \$2,579,019 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB-1;

WHEREAS, this is the second year in which the City of Pomona is receiving SB-1 funding, which enables the City of Pomona to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB-1;

WHEREAS, the City of Pomona utilized a Pavement Management System to develop the RMRA/SB-1 projects list to ensure revenues are being used on priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the City's priorities for transportation investment;

WHEREAS, according to the City of Pomona's Pavement Management System data, the City's Pavement Condition Index (PCI) for 2016 (current) is 64.5 for the overall/average network;

Resolution No. 2018-April 23, 2018 Page 1 of 4 **WHEREAS,** the funding from RMRA/SB-1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate approximately 11 streets, add active transportation infrastructure throughout the City this year, and many similar projects into the future;

WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in fair condition and this revenue will allow us to manage the overall quality of our roads;

WHEREAS, the RMRA/SB-1 projects list, overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits City and statewide;

WHEREAS, the program requires Cities and Counties to provide annual project reporting to the California Transportation Commission (CTC);

WHEREAS, annually, prior to receiving funds, a city or county must submit a proposed projects list from a Council-approved budget document containing the following: completed project description, completed date, amount of funds expended on the project, estimated useful life of the improvement, and a progress update on multi-year projects;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the FY 2018-19 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Project description for "Street Preservation – Local Citywide (FY 18-19)," Project No. 428-2590-xxxxx-68560 to include the eligible RMRA/SB-1 List of Street Projects shown in EXHIBIT "A-1" and the list of Measure M and other funded streets shown, including Additive Alternatives in EXHIBIT "A-1" for submittal to the CTC; and

WHEREAS, receipt of RMRA/SB-1 Local Street funding will require approval of the proposed Fiscal Year 2018-19 Public Works Operational Items List for qualified expenditures as shown in EXHIBIT "A-2".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby approves the Fiscal Year 2018-19 list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues, including the FY 18-19 CIP Project "Street Preservation – Local Citywide (FY 18-19)," Project No. 428-

2590-xxxxx-68560 by modifying the project description to include the Street Projects List, attached hereto as EXHIBIT "A-1."

- **SECTION 3.** The City Council hereby approves the Fiscal Year 2018-19 list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues including the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Public Works Operating Program Plan as shown on EXHIBIT "A-2".
- <u>SECTION 4</u>. The City Council hereby approves submittal of the RMRA/SB-1 Streets List for submittal to the California Transportation Commission (CTC) as shown on EXHIBIT "A-1" for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 funding.
- <u>SECTION 5</u>. The City Council hereby approves the list of items as shown in EXHIBIT "A-2" to be included in the Public Works Operational Plan and funded with RMRA/SB-1 Local Street funding and approves submittal to the CTC.
- **SECTION 6**. The City Council approves of Staff informing the California Transportation Commission that the City of Pomona's Pavement Management System overall/average network 2016 (current) Pavement Condition Index (PCI) is 64.5.
- **SECTION 7**. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any documents required for receipt of RMRA/SB-1 and Measure M funding, including annual reporting forms, and any documents that may be required by legislative funding guidelines.
- **SECTION 8.** The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
