## **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A) GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE SAN JOSE CREEK GREENWAY TRAIL PROJECT TO THE CALIFORNIA NATURAL RESOURCES AGENCY'S URBAN GREENING PROGRAM FOR A TOTAL GRANT REQUEST OF \$2,675,363

- **WHEREAS**, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the program shown above;
- **WHEREAS**, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures;
- **WHEREAS**, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency requires a resolution certifying the approval of application by the Applicant's Governing Board (City of Pomona City Council) before submission of said application to the State;
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Pomona, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out the project; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council has the authority to approve the submittal of applications for grants related to California Natural Resources Agency's Urban Greening Program.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:
- **SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby authorizes Staff to submit one (1) grant application for the San Jose Creek Greenway Trail to the Urban Greening Program.
  - **SECTION 2.** That the City understands the assurance and certification in the application.
- **SECTION 3.** That the City will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project consistent with land tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so.
- **SECTION 4.** That the City will comply with all provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.
- **SECTION 5.** That, if applicable, the project will comply with all laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws, and that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have been obtained.
- **SECTION 6.** That the City will work towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1.
- **SECTION 7.** The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, as agent for the City of Pomona, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

**SECTION 8.** The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
