SUMMARY

Recommendation. Staff recommends the Cultural Arts Commission Citizens Advisory Committee (CACCAC) approve Public Arts Permit No. 10046-2018 to allow installation of orange crate labels on each tower wall of a new freestanding wireless communication facility designed as a stealth tower.

PREVIOUS PLANNING ACTIONS:

1/10/18 Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 18-001 approving Major Wireless Communication Facility Permit (WIRE 2662-2015), subject to conditions, for a wireless communication facility designed as a stealth tower.

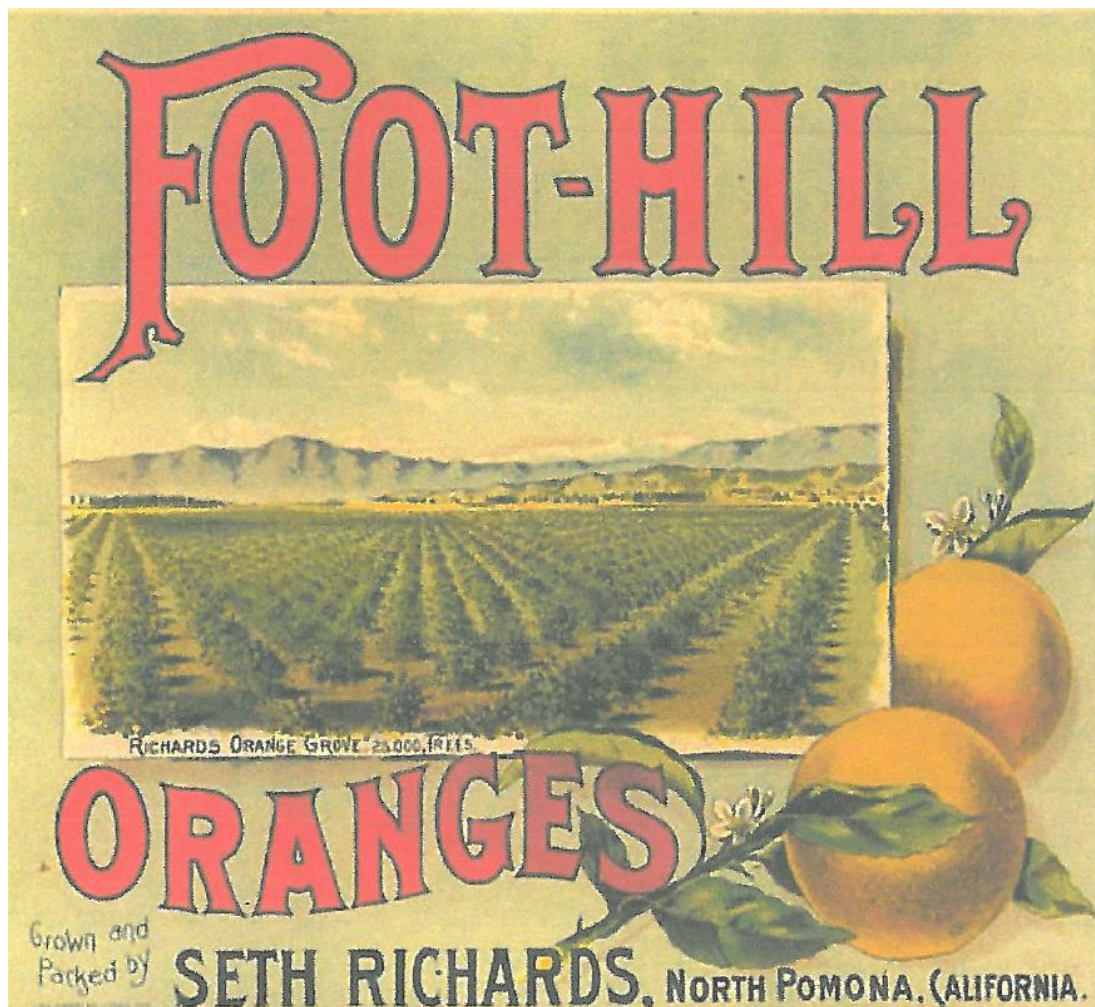
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On January 10, 2018, the Planning Commission approved Major Wireless Communication Facility Permit (WIRE 2662-2015) to allow the establishment of a new 45' tall freestanding wireless communication facility designed as a stealth tower in the parking lot of a commercial property. As part of the approval, the project was required, per Condition of Approval No. 25, to install

Pomona orange crate labels, on each of the tower walls to be reviewed and approved by the Cultural Arts Commission and the Development Services Manager.

The proposed wireless communication facility will be located within an existing parking lot area of a commercial property. The tower structure will consist of a simulated wood enclosure which rests on four tower legs with cross-bracing. The antennas and all tower mounted support equipment will be installed behind the tower enclosure. The tower mounted equipment will consist of three separate antenna sectors, each sector consisting of four panel antennas for a total of twelve antennas.

The applicant has proposed to install "Foot-hill Oranges" orange crate label artwork on each of the tower walls.



Renderings of the proposed stealth tower with orange crate labels has been included as an attachment to the staff report (Attachment 2).
