SUMMARY

Recommendation: Staff recommends the Cultural Arts Commission Citizens Advisory Committee (CACCAC) approve Concept Design Plan Application (PUBART 10305-2018) to allow installation of a contemporary non-representational sculpture in an auburn hue patina paying homage to the beauty and form of the sycamore tree and to request the applicant to submit a Final Design Plan to the Planning Division for Cultural Arts Commission consideration.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed sculpture is entitled "Standing Together," by artist Ron Jobson. The sculpture is defined as "a contemporary non-representational sculpture in an auburn hue patina paying homage to the beauty and form of the sycamore tree" (Attachment 1). It consists of a rusted 1.5" diameter steel tube and 1/8" thick plate steel leaves. Multiple leaves per "trunk" are hand hammered, bent, and wrought in different sizes. The assumed height is 12 feet. The estimated project value is \$20,685. The proposed sculpture will be located at the front of the 12-unit residential development, visible to passerby and the general public along White Avenue (Attachment 3).

Mr. Jobson's output "has primarily been contemporary in nature and typically works with metals, such as aluminum, stainless steel, copper, brass and rusted/corten steel." Mr. Jobson has produced pieces for both commercial and private clients for over 20 years (Attachment 2).
