- Our graduates matriculate to top Universities in China, US, and Western Europe.

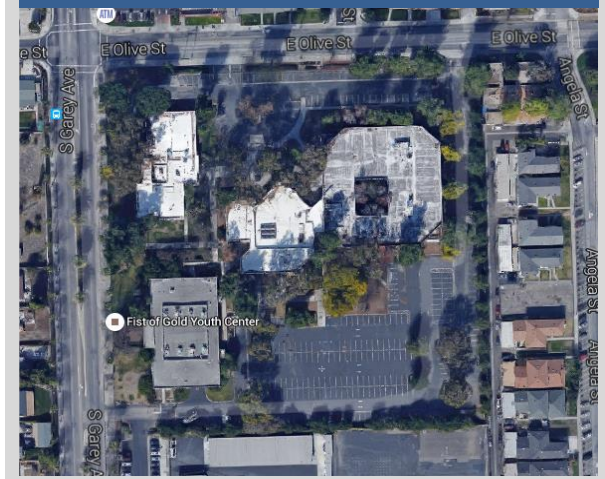
What We Want to Do

3. We Host Community Events / Social Gatherings

- Our campus will feature many meeting rooms, conference rooms, and beautiful high ceiling assembly space that can serve as venues for community events and social gatherings for various groups of community leaders, fundraisers, and teams.
- We are also pursuing the possibility of acquiring nearby land, so we may have a beautiful field for outdoor sports and activities.

Our Students and Families

- Initially the majority of students will be coming from our overseas school, 21st CIS, as part of the 6th and 9th grade exchange program.
- Students will stay in on campus dorms (very little traffic, no issues with pick up or drop off, little change to traffic for neighborhood).
- Our students come primarily from strong middle-upper class families who are business owners and industry leaders in tech, entertainment, and more. When the students come, the parents will also come and increase the economic activity in nearby areas.

Faculty and Staff

- Initially about half of our teachers, administrative, and supporting staff will accompany students from overseas and will reside in on-campus housing to supervise students in their various activities and study hall after school. The other half will be carefully selected locally.
- Students will be well taken care of and supervised at all times by experienced and well trained faculty and staff.

Campus

- Our campus is a beautiful 9 acre site with over 110,000 sqft of existing buildings, located right off the 60 and 71 highways on Garey Ave.
- We are currently working with Pomona city planning to obtain our CUP. This site used to be a high school many years ago, and a few years ago a CUP was already approved to operate an international school.

Environmental Impact

- We will have a low impact on the environment: our campus will be quiet, clean and private boarding school.

General Operation Information

- Hours of operation are 7am – 9pm which includes afterschool programs and study hall
- Campus is closed to general public, students and authorized visitors only
- All programs will be supervised with teacher to student ratio of 1:10-20 including afterschool programs, dormitories, and study hall.
- On-campus bookstore for books and supplies
- “Lights out” is at 10pm for student dorms

1. Short Term Programs

- 1-year exchange experience America program: English language and literature, US History and social studies, core classes in math and science, and electives in arts and technology

2. Long Term Programs

- 6-year formal junior high school for college preparation: full high school course load to prepare for matriculation to US college or university.
