**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING LOT MERGER LM7-2018 OF LOTS 3 THROUGH 11, BLOCK M OF THE GANESHA PARK TRACT RECORDED IN BOOK 14 PAGES 74 AND 75 OF MAPS AND A PORTION OF LOT 5 OF THE ALVARADO TRACT RANCHO SAN JOSE RECORDED IN BOOK 37 PAGE 49 OF MISCELLANEOUS RECORDS, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, ASSESSOR PARCEL NUMBERS 8357-010-900 AND -901 FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT OF THE ROOSEVELT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED AT 701 N. HUNTINGTON STREET, POMONA, CA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pomona Public Works Department has received a request for lot merger LM7-2018 of Lots 3 through 11, Block M of the Ganesha Park Tract recorded in Book 14 Pages 74 and 75 of Maps and a portion of Lot 5 of the Alvarado Tract Rancho San Jose recorded in Book 37 Page 49 of Miscellaneous Records, County of Los Angeles, Assessor Parcel Numbers 8357-010-900 and -901, located at 701 N. Huntington Street and 731 Laurel Avenue respectively, Pomona, CA;

**WHEREAS**, Eric Andreasen with Andreasen Engineering, Inc., on behalf of Pomona Unified School District, owner of the adjoining real properties located at 701 N. Huntington Street and 731 Laurel Avenue, Assessor Parcel Numbers 8357-010-900 and -901, has submitted all required documents for review by the City Engineer, pursuant to Section 66499.20.3 of the California Government Code (Subdivision Map Act);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 78-1 of the Pomona City Code, Section 29-50 (b), unless a project related to the subject lot merger has been previously considered by the Planning Commission, final approval of the lot merger shall be made by City Council;

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer has reviewed the completed application for the proposed lot merger for compliance with the Subdivision Map Act and applicable City Codes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Division has reviewed the completed application for the proposed lot merger for compliance with the City's General Plan, Zoning Ordinance and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15061 of the Guidelines for the implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Section 15061 refers to activities covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby declares the above recitals are true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** The Notice of Lot Merger LM7-2018 attached hereto as EXHIBIT 1 is hereby approved as depicted by legal description and map marked as EXHIBIT "A" and Resolution No. 2018-

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EXHIBIT “B” attached hereto and by reference made a part thereof and determined to be in compliance with California Government Code Section 66499.20.3.

**SECTION 3.** The City Engineer is hereby authorized to sign the Notice of Lot Merger on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 4.** The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and it shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
