

**CERTIFICATE OF DETERMINATION OF EXAMINATION OF
INITIATIVE PETITION BASED ON STATISTICAL SAMPLING
(Cal. Elections Code sec. 9115(b))**

I, Marie Michel Macias, Interim City Clerk of the City of Pomona, County of Los Angeles, State of California, hereby certify that:

The petition entitled "AN INITIATIVE MEASURE TO ENACT A THREE-QUARTER PERCENT (0.75%) INCREASE IN THE CITY'S UTILITY USERS TAX FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS UNLESS EXTENDED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, AND ESTABLISH AN EXEMPTION OF THE USER UTILITY TAX FOR LEGALLY HANDICAPPED RESIDENTIAL RATE PAYERS" was filed with the City Clerk's Office on August 28, 2018.

That said petition consists of 1,113 signatures purporting to be signatures of qualified electors of the City of Pomona, California;

That attached to this petition at the time it was filed, was an affidavit purporting to be the affidavit of the person who solicited the signatures, and containing the dates between which the purported qualified electors signed this petition;

That the affiant stated his or her own qualification, that he or she had solicited the signatures upon that Section, that all of the signatures were made in his or her presence, and that to the best of his or her own information and belief, each signature to that section was the genuine signature of the person whose name it purports to be;

That after the proponents filed this petition and based on the County of Los Angeles Registrar of Voters' Signature Verification system, and the Elections Official (City Clerk) application of the random sampling for verification of signatures formula, I have determined the following facts regarding this petition:

1. Total number of signatures filed by proponent (preliminary)	<u>1,143</u>
2. Total number of signatures filed by proponent (final):	<u>1,113</u>
3. Total number of signatures verified (random draw):	<u>500</u>
4. Number of signatures found sufficient (based on random draw):	<u>418</u>
5. Number of signatures found insufficient (based on random draw):	<u>82</u>
6. Number of signatures insufficient because of duplication:	<u>3</u>
7. Value of each signature	<u>2.226</u>
8. Penalty Value of Duplicate Signatures	<u>2.73</u>
9. Total Value of Duplicate Signatures	<u>8.19</u>
10. Adjusted number of Valid Signatures	<u>930</u>
11. Adjusted number of Valid Signatures minus Duplicate Signatures	<u>922</u>
12. Statistical Total as a Percent of Total Needed to Qualify	<u>122.97%</u>

Based on the above, the statistical sampling performed demonstrates that the percentage of valid signatures of qualified voters (122.97% of sampled signatures) is over 110 percent of the number of signatures of qualified voters needed to declare the petition sufficient.
