ORDINANCE NO. 4255

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POMONA AMENDING SECTION 58-294 OF THE POMONA CITY CODE PERTAINING TO TRUCK ROUTE DESIGNATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Pomona is authorized by Article XI, "Local Government," §5 and §7 of the California State Constitution to exercise the police power of the State by adopting regulations to promote public health, public safety and general prosperity, and other ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws.

WHEREAS, the City of Pomona has authority pursuant to Sections 21101, "Local Regulation" and 35700, "Local Authorities," of the California Vehicle Code to prohibit the use of particular highways by certain vehicles, including by weight, subject to certain exceptions.

WHEREAS, the Mobility and Access Component of the City of Pomona General Plan provides under the "Truck Routes" section that "The City will make every effort to maintain direct access from industrial- and special-event-oriented land use districts to expressways and other high-capacity regional thoroughfares," and that "On the other hand, streets with higher volumes of pedestrians and bicyclists and relatively few trucks should be reclassified." The General Plan envisions the possibility that, on the basis of an appropriate evaluation, the City may designate specific citywide truck routes and implement weight restrictions to direct truck traffic flows along the appropriate street network, and to prevent trucks from impacting local neighborhoods and schools in the City. As such, this Ordinance is consistent with the General Plan.

WHEREAS, certain Sections in Article V, Division 2 of the City of Pomona Municipal Code, "Truck Routes," address commercial vehicle weight restrictions on city streets.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Pomona as follows:

SECTION 1. That Pomona City Code Section 58-294, is hereby amended by adjusting the truck routes for those City streets, or portions thereof, listed below:

Truck routes are as follows:
All state highways throughout the city.
Arrow Highway, from the west city boundary east to the east city boundary.
Bonita Avenue, from the west city boundary east to Towne Avenue.
E Street, from the north city boundary to McKinley Avenue.
Garey Avenue, from the south city boundary north to State Highway Route 66.
Holt Avenue, from Indian Hill Boulevard east to the east city boundary.
Indian Hill Boulevard, from Holt Avenue north to the Interstate 10.
La Verne Avenue, from Arrow Highway southeasterly to Garey Avenue.
Mission Boulevard, from the west city boundary to the east city boundary.
Mission Boulevard, from Reservoir Street east to east city boundary.
Phillips Boulevard, from Garey Avenue east to the east city boundary.

Pomona Boulevard, from Garey Avenue east to the east city boundary.
<i>Reservoir Street,</i> from the south city boundary north to <u>Mission Boulevard</u> .
Second Street, from State Highway Route 71 east to White Avenue.
Temple Avenue, from Valley Boulevard to Mission Boulevard.
<i>Towne Avenue</i> , from Interstate 10 north to State Highway Route 66.
Valley Boulevard, from the west city boundary east to State Highway Route 71.
White Avenue, from Mission Boulevard north to the north city boundary.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause same to be posted as required by law, and this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its final adoption.
